

# Use of Quiet Room Consent Form

## Nipisihkopahk Education Authority

At Nipisihkopahk Education Authority (NEA), we believe that all behavioural interventions assume a regard for the well-being and dignity of students and staff. Use of the Quiet Room should be a proactive strategy used to support self-monitoring, student self-reflection, and self-calming. It should only be used after less restrictive measures have not been successful and the behaviour poses an immediate threat to self and/or others. Every effort will be made help the student self-regulate before use of the Quiet Room is considered. Students placed in the quiet room will be visually monitored by an adult at all times.

NEA requires that informed parental consent must be obtained in order to utilize the Quiet Room. If a child has been placed in the Quiet Room, every effort will be made to inform the parent/guardian by the end of that school day.

Students may request use of the Quiet Room at any time.

I give permission for staff, of Nipisihkopahk Education Authority, to place my child in the Quiet Room only when my child poses a threat of imminent harm to self or others and when other less restrictive interventions have failed or been deemed inappropriate.
